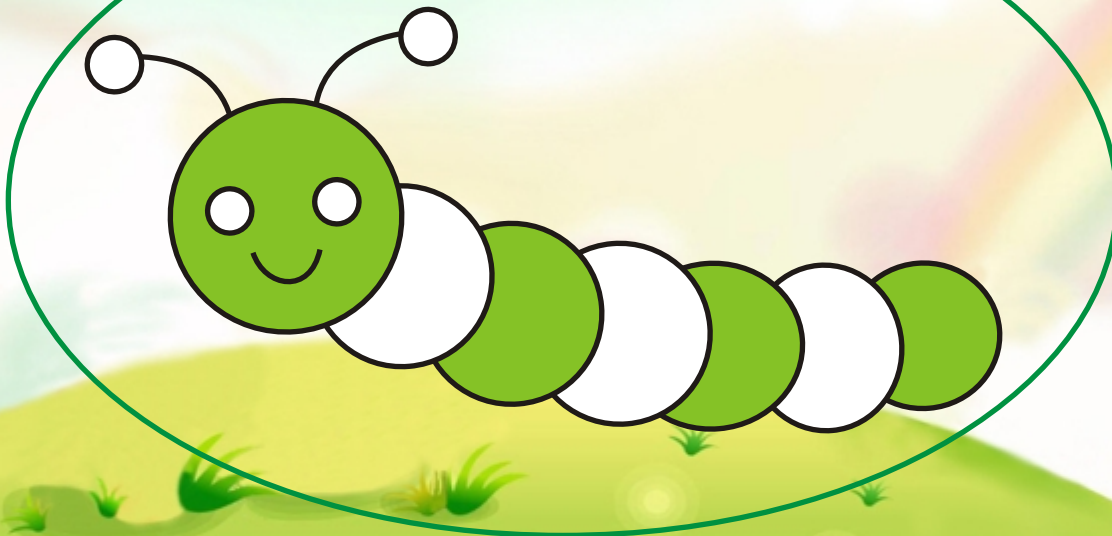

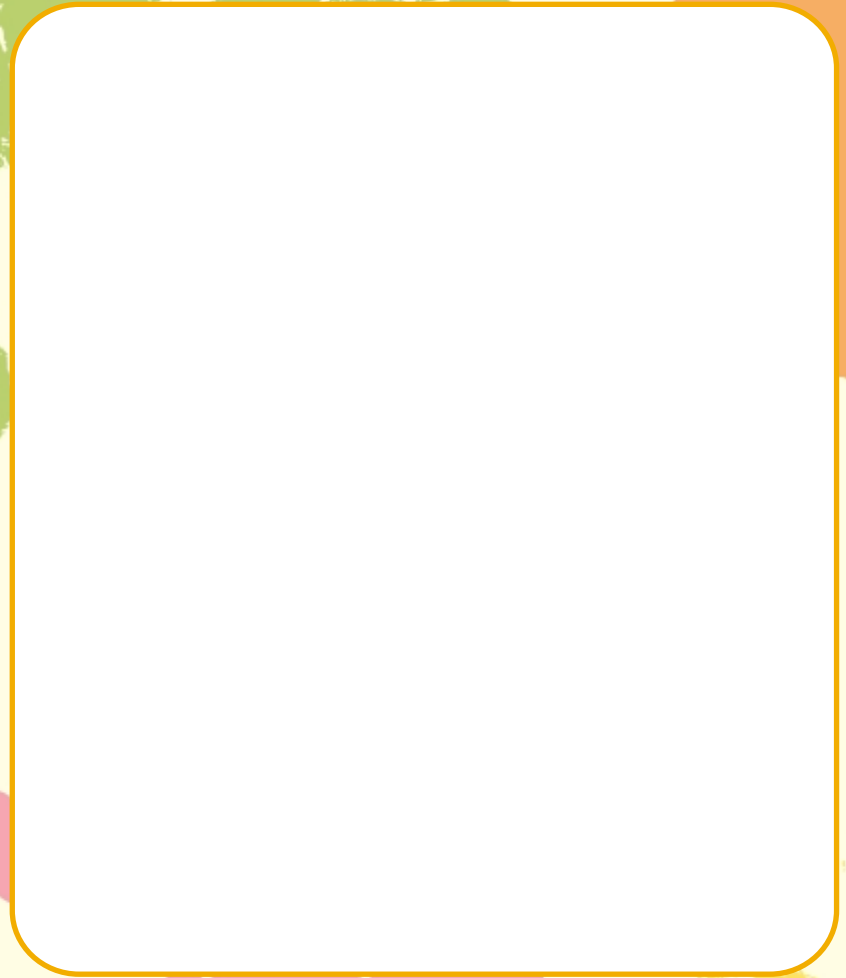

Involvement Tips

*"To be in your children's memories tomorrow,

A child is a bundle of joy which has come through you and arrived in your house. But there is no single rule with which we can deal with all children. Different children need different levels of attention, expression of love and toughness. Looking at the coconut tree if we think it needs 50 litres of water per day and when we go back home and water the rose plant also in the same manner, it will die. So, we must see what kind of child we have and how he has to be raised.

Gift of Time : The greatest gift you can give your child is that of time and there is no substitute of it.

Give space : Creativity and imagination needs free space.

Allow mistakes : This is the only way children learn.

Be around : Presence of both the parents in child's foundation years help him to blossom into a confident, independent and lovable child.

Avoid instant gratification of demands :

Children learn to be patient and value things.

Trust and be trusted : Let us trust our children and be trusted by them in return.

Ignoring can reduce any attention seeking misbehaviour : Common behaviour that can be reduced or eliminated with ignoring include whining, temper tantrums etc.

Respect their individuality and uniqueness : Child learns to accept and respect himself and others.

Attending your child's school and sports events : It's important for the child to show off his accomplishments to you. So you must make an effort to attend all the school functions.

Grandparents are invaluable : Children learn strong values by just being around their grandparents.

Praise the positive behaviour :
Appreciation can reinforce a child's confidence and it ensures them that you are noticing when they are trying to follow the rules.

Model the traits you wish to cultivate in your kids: Respect, friendliness, honesty, kindness, tolerance. Treat your kids the way you expect other people to treat you.
