It may be that this kind of tongue does help them to talk, but it certainly isn't necessary in order for a bird to be able to talk. Other 'talking' birds, such as mynas, crows, and ravens, don't have large, thick tongues. Hawks and eagles do have such tongues—and can't talk!

It may be that parrots can 'talk' because their voice mechanism and hearing work more slowly than those of other birds. And probably the sounds made by human beings resemble the sounds naturally made by parrots, so it is easy for them to imitate them. (words 146)
