PICK-O-MAX: ROBOTICS

Classes : VI - VIII

Number of Participants : 2

Time Duration : 5 min

Instructions

- Each team will be required to bring their own completely assembled picker bot.
- Bot dimensions should not exceed the maximum of 60cmX60cmX60cm.
- Maximum voltage supply – 12 V.
- Max weight – 3.5 Kgs.
- The bots can be wired or wireless.
- Length of the wire should not be less than 5m (if wired).
- Teams will be provided with a defined arena in which some objects will be scattered/ spread. The teams have to pick as many objects as possible and drop them into the finishing line in the given time.
- There will be negative marking if the bots perform any foul.
- The escort teacher/coach is not allowed to enter the arena and help the students in any way.

- Dimensions of the Bot.
- Number of objects picked.
