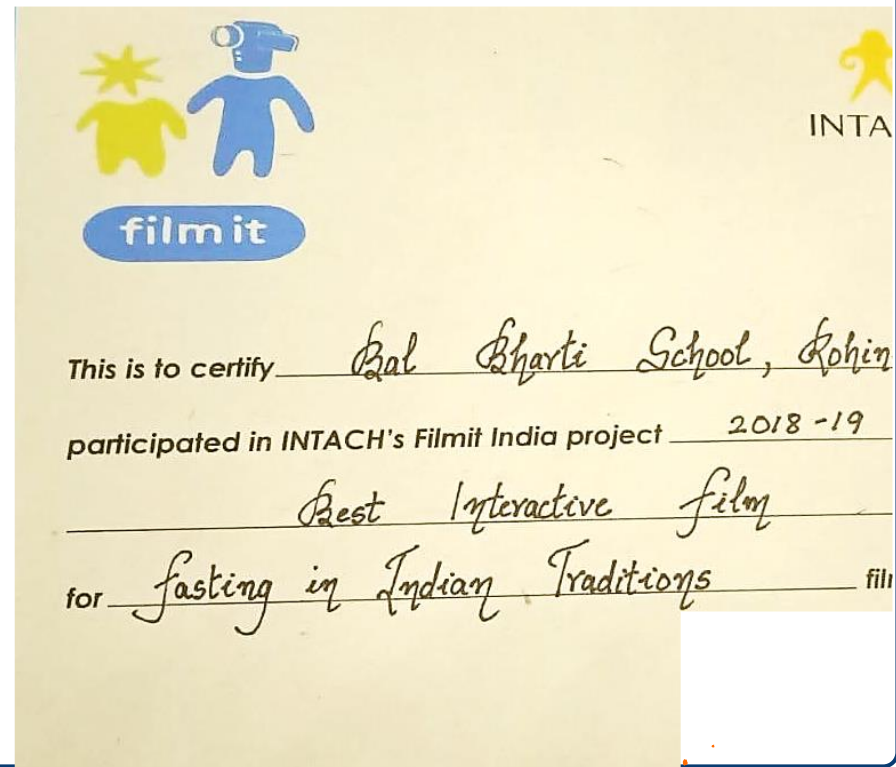
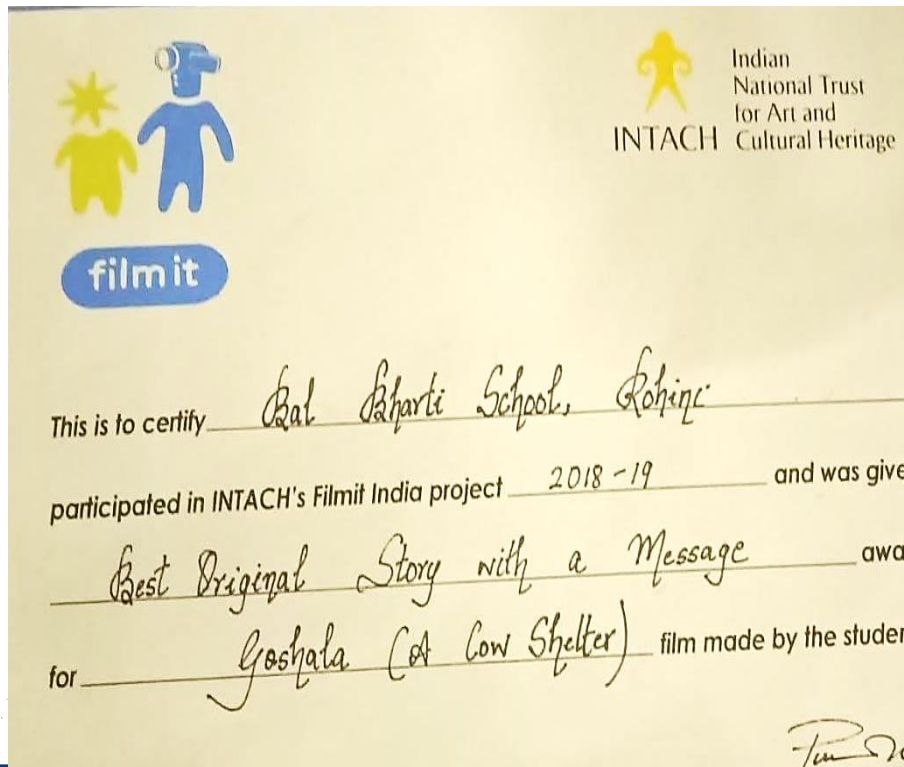
# FILMIT AWARDS
