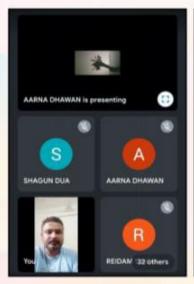


Waste to Wonder - Get Crafty



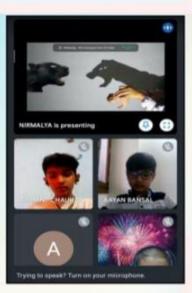
