- In case you are not able to locate your child, do not panic, contact the school staff available in the premises.

Wear mask and instruct your ward to wear the mask properly at all times. Your mask protects us and our mask protects you. Don't send your ward to school in case he shows Covid like symptoms. Share all relevant & required information with the school proactively. Let's all be safe & healthy.
