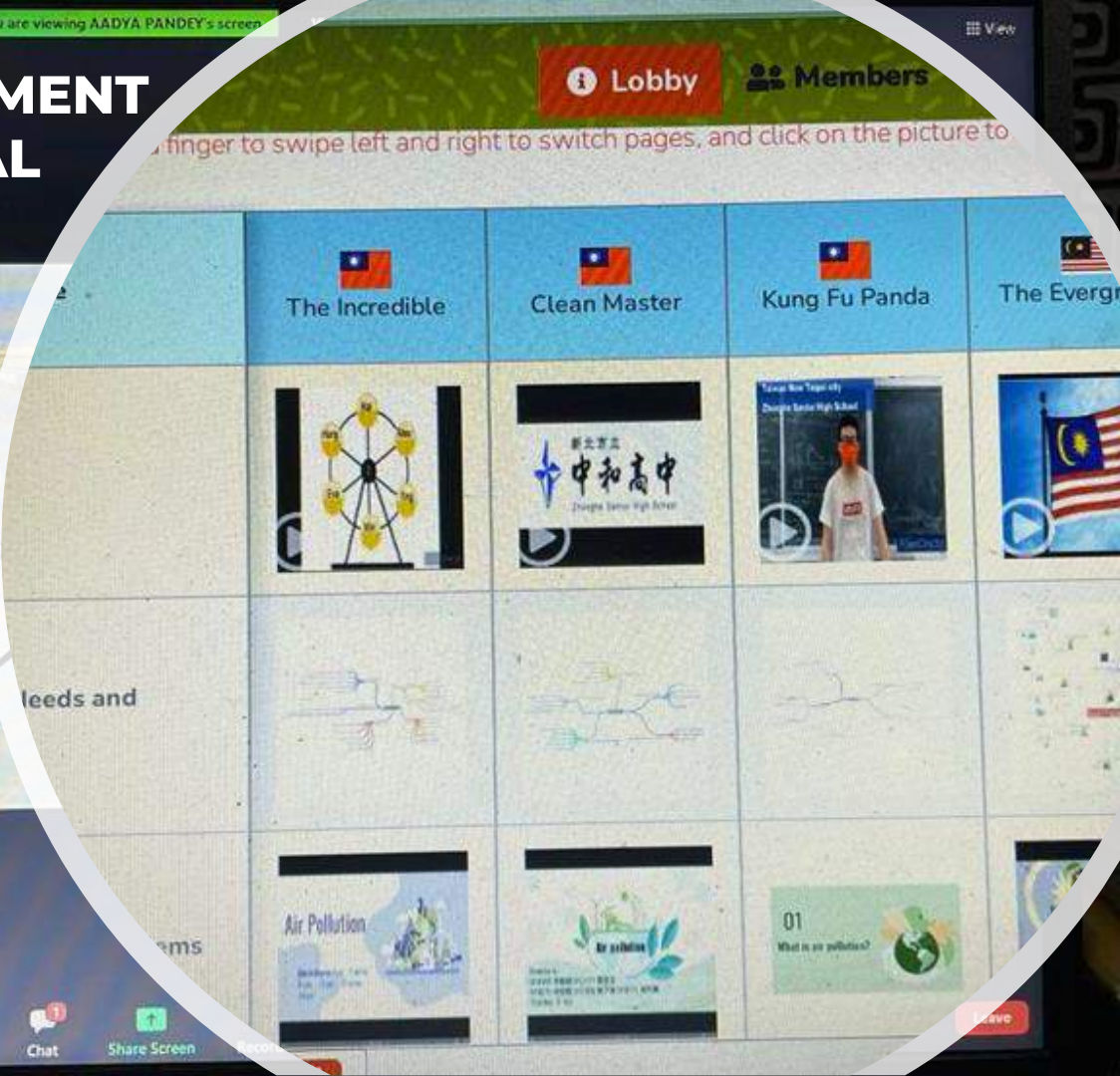
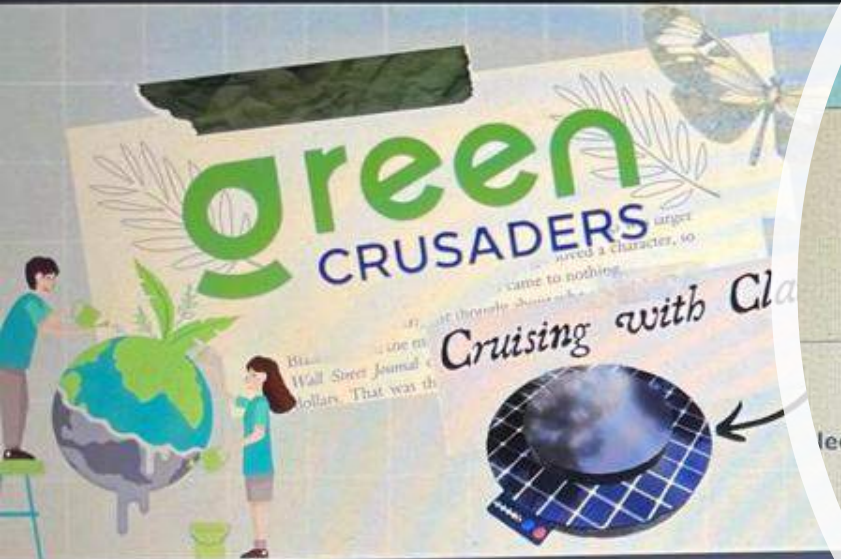


# COMMENDABLE ACHEIVEMENT IN 2021 iLINC CARNIVAL PROGRAM

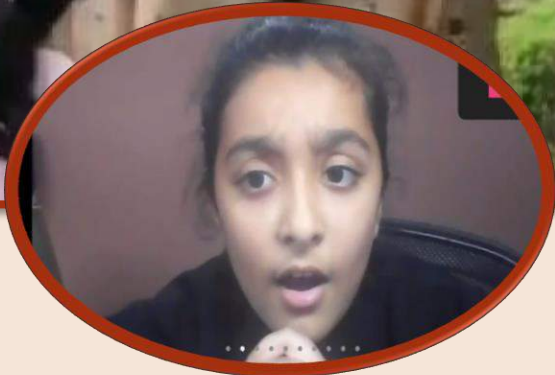

## ‘Students should strive for competencies and skills that will take them closer to their future aspirations’

In these politically volatile times, should students be insulated from political upheavals? How do you inform/educate them about the changing scenarios?

With increased awareness due to technology advancements, our young children are already in the know-how of what is happening in their city, state or country and the world. There is no insulating them from the political upheavals and intricacies of the present times. The important task here for an educator is to hone their ability to discuss and engage in meaningful conversation. They should be taught about our constitution, our aspirations as a nation and then, provided platforms to navigate their own thoughts and beliefs and sync them with the bigger political ecosystem. Schools can be the safe spaces wherein the children take part in different activities of political nature and embark on journey to formulating their own political ideology.




## NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY
