Dear parents

The school is all set to welcome back the students after the summer vacations. A lot of effort is being made to create a safe & conducive environment for the students in the school premises. A plan has been made for the smooth dispersal of students after the school gets over. You are requested to make a note of the dispersal plan given below:

- I PRIMARY: [Classes I-V] (Dispersal will start from 1:35 pm onwards)
 - 1. Van users will assemble in the Multi Utility Complex to disperse from Gate No. 3.
 - 2. For students who are to be picked up by their parents:
 Classes I A to I E & II E: to be picked from their classrooms
 Classes II A to II D & III A to III E: to be picked from Block I, Courtyard
 Classes IV A to IV E & V A to V E: to be picked from Block III, Courtyard
 - 3. Bus Users will board their buses from the school premises.
- II MIDDLE: [Classes VI-VIII] (Dispersal will start from 1:50 pm onwards)
 - 1. Van users will assemble in the Multi Utility Complex to disperse from Gate No. 3.
 - 2. For students who are to be picked up by their parents:
 - Classes VI: Students will assemble in the area behind the school reception: to be picked up by their parents & disperse from Gate No. 1.
 - Classes VII: Students will assemble near Gate No 2: to be picked up by their parents & disperse from Gate No. 1.
 - Classes VIII: Students will disperse from Gate No. 4.
 - 3. Bus Users will board their buses from the school premises.
- III SENIOR: [Classes IX-XII] (Dispersal will start from 1:40 pm onwards)
 - 1. Van users will assemble in the Multi Utility Complex to disperse from Gate No. 3.
 - 2. The students going on their own will disperse from Gate No. 3.
 - 3. The students who are to be picked up by their parents will disperse from Gate No. 4.
 - 4. Bus Users will board the buses from the school premises.

PS: On a rainy day, the students who are picked up by their parents can be collected from the classrooms itself.
