AS A CITIZEN

AS A MEMBER OF COMMUNITY

1. Respect the rights, dignity and feelings of others. Wait for your turn, do not jump the queue, wait to be served; be courteous and polite; refrain from rowdy or disruptive behavior in public.
2. Do not disturb your neighbours by playing loud music or honking or encroaching upon their freedom & space by blocking their driveway & parking lot.
3. Water and electricity are scarce. Switch off electric fan, tubelight, TV, computer and turn off the water tap when not in use.
4. Do not throw litter around or in the open. Use garbage bins instead.
5. Help the poor, the underprivileged and the physically handicapped or mentally challenged in whatever way you can.

DO'S AND DON'T'S FOR STUDENTS

DO'S

1. Come to school clean, well groomed and in proper uniform. Wear I-card. It is mandatory.
2. Be regular and punctual.
3. Attend morning assembly without fail.
4. Be fair and honest at work, always be considerate of the rights of others and be a good sportsman.
5. Be courteous and respectful to peers, parents, teachers and elders.
6. Look after the property of the school, and help to keep it clean and tidy.

7. Keep your classroom clean and tidy.
8. Switch off the fans and lights when not in use.
9. Conserve water.
10. Be compassionate and empathetic.

DON'Ts -

1. Report to school before 7.15 am in the morning.
2. Bring articles of value such as pieces of jewellery or cash, camera, iPad or other electronic items like mobile phones to school.
3. Bring prohibited items like guns, knives, explosives, firecrackers, pepper spray and other irritant sprays.
4. Indulge in any form of gambling.
5. Disfigure or damage any school property.
6. Absent yourself from school without written application. 75% attendance is the minimum requirement.
7. Be rowdy/rude or use any form of violence or physical abuse.
8. Misbehave with peers, teachers or any other employee of the school.
9. Bully/Intimidate others.
10. Disturb classes intentionally.
11. Discriminate on the basis of caste/community/colour/gender/linguistic identity.
12. Disobey lawful orders of the Teacher/Vice-Principal/ Principal.
13. Steal/pilferage school/student's property.
14. Be in possession or under influence of any illegal drug.
15. Indulge in acts of immoral and insensitive behaviors such as use of profane language, exchange of sexually explicit matter etc.
16. Indulge in emotionally disturbing or abusive behaviour.

- Strive for excellence in all fields. Set high but realistic goals and ideals for yourself.
- Keep off addictions. Don't succumb to temptations or peer pressure.
