¹⁰HIGHLIGHTS OF BALANCE SHEET AS ON 31.03.2022

School Fund:

1. At the beginning of the year 2021-22, the school had a negative General Fund of Rs 49.82 Lakhs. During the year, the school has deficit due to which the negative General Fund as on 31 March 2022 is Rs 58.70 Lakhs. Total Salary Reserve as on 31 March 2022 is Rs 2.82 crores though the required Salary Reserve is around Rs 4.40 crores approx.
2. Fee collected from students is Rs 15.66 crores after providing 15% concession on Annual Charges in accordance with the judgement of Hon'ble High court of Delhi. This includes Rs 14.25 Crores of Tuition Fee whereas the Establishment cost is Rs 14.77 crores which constitutes 103.65% of the tuition fee collected from students.
3. Administrative expenses are 9.58% and other expenses (incl R&M) are 1.29%, of total income during the year.
4. The school has total FDR, Current Assets & Loans, Advances & Deposits balance of Rs 8.67 crores towards statutory & other liabilities.
5. The amount of Gratuity and Leave Encashment Provision is Rs 12.38 crores against which school have deposited Rs 9.79 crores with LIC.

Development Fund :

1. The development fee received during the year is amounting to Rs 1.29 crores after providing 15% concession in accordance with the judgement of Hon'ble Court of Delhi.
2. The capital expenditure incurred during the year 2021-22 amounted to Rs 1.95 Crores.
3. Depreciation charged to I&E Account amounts to Rs 1.33 crores. An amount equivalent to Depreciation has been added to Depreciation Reserve Fund.
4. Unutilized balance in Restricted Fund is Rs 4.29 crores and the total FDR, Current Assets & Loans, Advances and deposits balance is Rs 4.31 crores.

Activity Fund :

1. Deficit for the year (2021-22) is Rs. 17.21 lakhs.
2. Fees for Activities collected from students is Rs 33.86 lakhs on account of Activity Fees from Skill development and Orientation Programme which is collected from New Admissions during the year. This fund is spent on students for their overall orientation and skill development activities over the years.
3. The ratio of expenses to total income is 136.94% approx.
4. Depreciation charged to I & E Account amounts to Rs 14 Thousand and the same has been added to depreciation Reserve Fund.
5. At the end of the year, unutilized balance in Restricted Fund is Rs 23.66 Lakhs.

Transport Fund :

1. Deficit for the year is Rs 24.99 Lakhs and there is negative General Fund as on 31.03.2022 amounting to Rs 80 Lakhs.
2. There is no Transport Fee collected during 2 years due to physical closure of school in pandemic. However, the school has borne the fixed expenses amounting Rs 24.61 lakhs during the year.
3. There is a small income on account of interest amounting Rs 2.30 Lakhs.
4. Depreciation charged to I&E Account amounts to Rs 2.69 lakhs. An amount equivalent to Depreciation has been added to Depreciation Reserve Fund.
5. Total Current Assets, Loans, Advances & Deposits balance is Rs 8.36 Lakhs towards statutory & other liabilities.
6. The amount of Gratuity and Leave Encashment Provision is Rs 48.76 lakhs against which we have deposited Rs 25.89 lakhs with LIC.

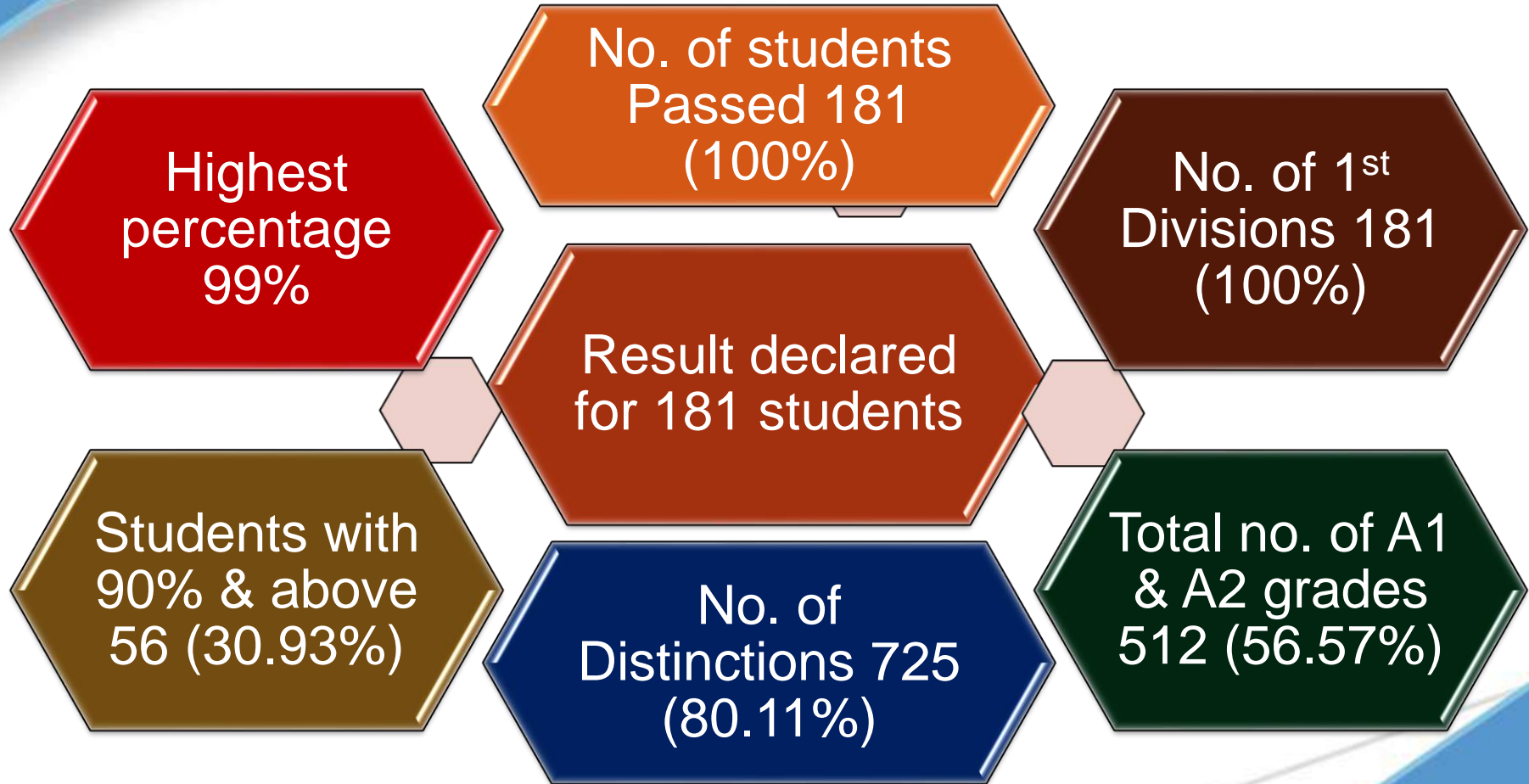

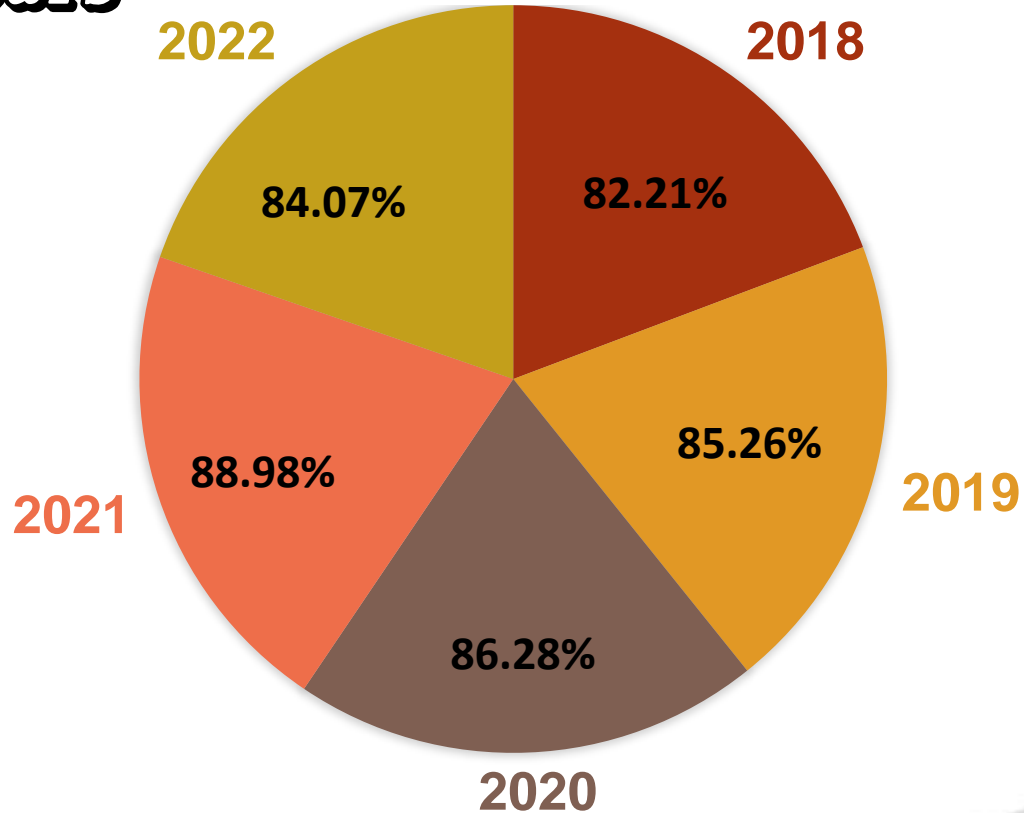

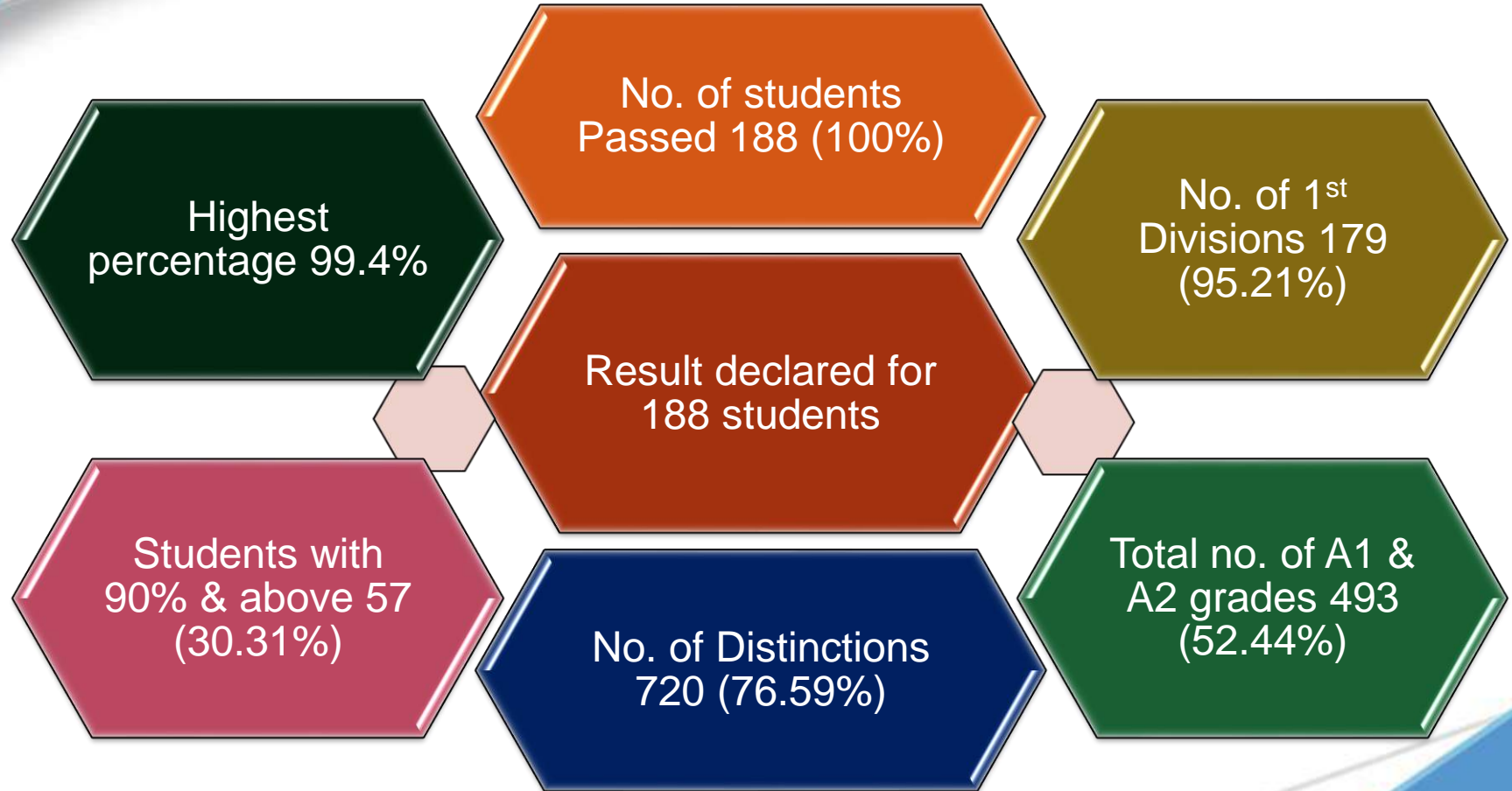

Comparative Result of X Five years

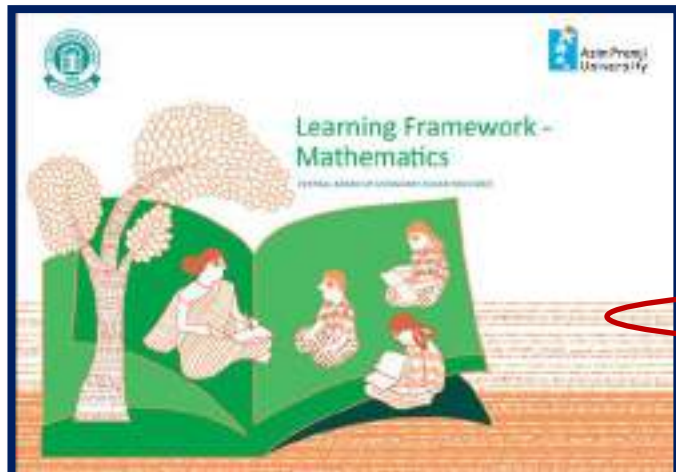
