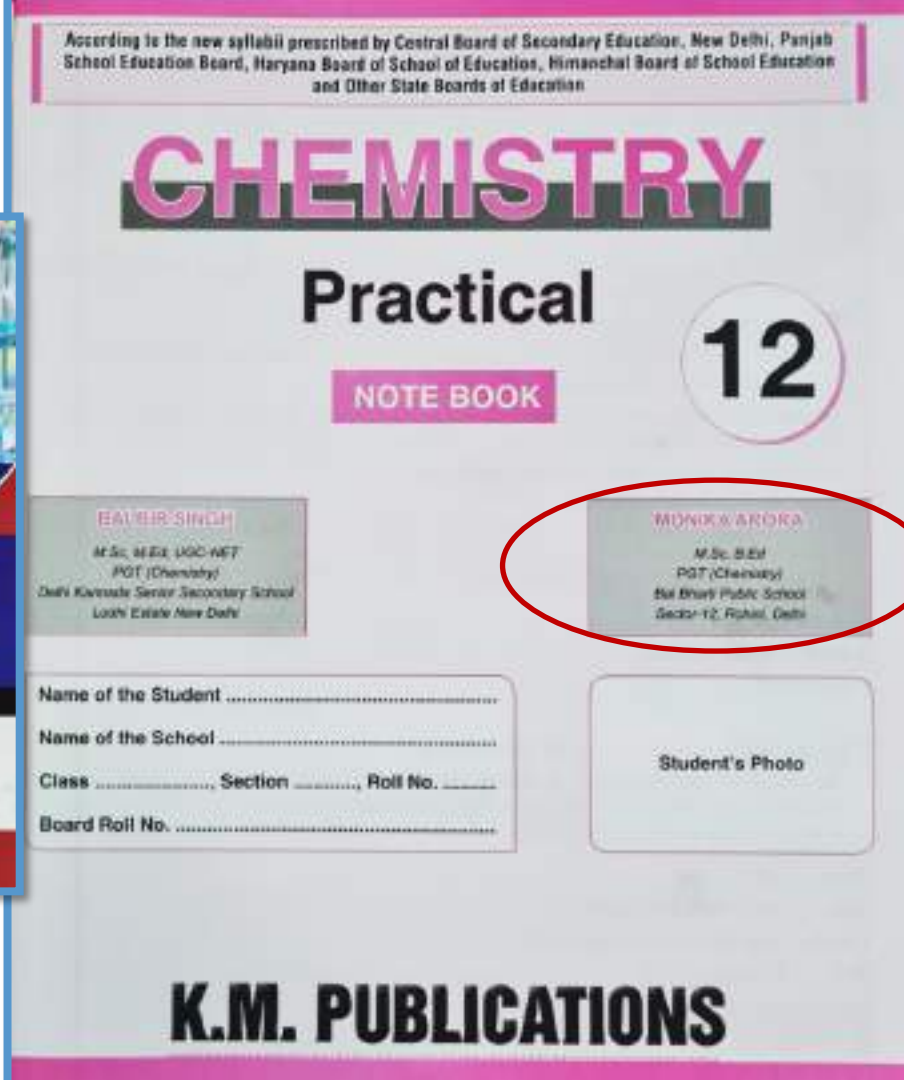
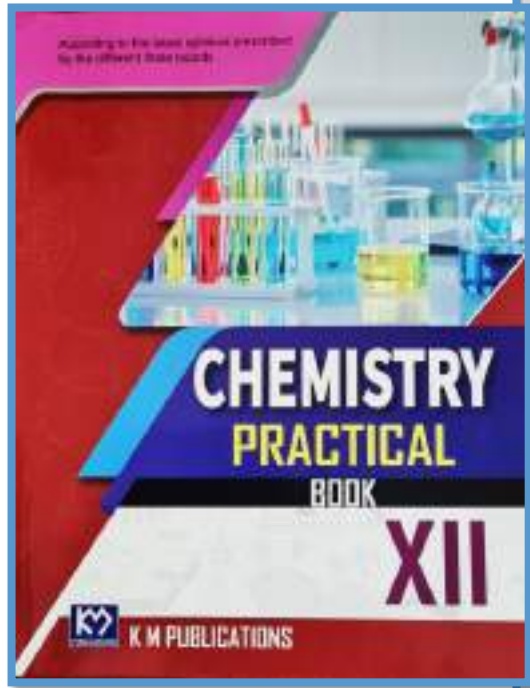
21st-century learning skills have 4C's. And there are four skills that students need in this fast-paced digital world.

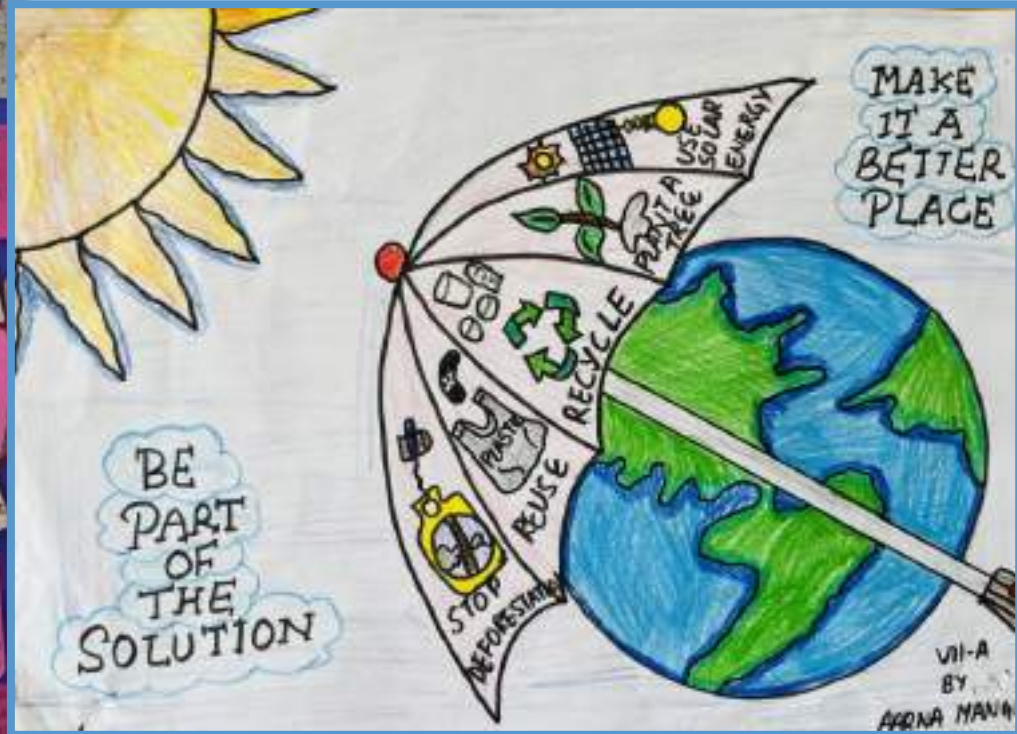

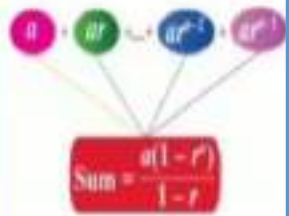
THE STORY OF ORIGIN

After the Economic Times (Industry), the premier rise of literacy in India in the past two decades has been plagued by rising unemployment amongst skilled personnel. For July 2022, the overall unemployment rate in the country was 6.30% but unemployment amongst well-educated youth was and still remains to be almost twice the national average of unemployment. Thus, for India, unemployment is a bigger problem than underemployment. In addition, 50% of the working population is self-employed, out of which 20% are either struggling or operating on the margin.

Amongst many strategies that are being chalked out and implemented to address the unemployment issue, integrating entrepreneurship skills in education is the most effective one. Entrepreneurship need to be integrated into education as holistically as Science, Mathematics, Technology and Language. We need to ensure that youth shift their focus from seeking jobs to creating marketable opportunities for themselves.

Further entrepreneurship skills: Giving small seed money to every class to execute a simple, age-appropriate business plan is being experimented by schools.

Some activities executed successfully at BPS, Rohini include Campaign to Corporate-Internship Programme, Project Based Learning, Developing Apps and Prototypes, Introduction of Entrepreneurship Mentor curriculum in class XI, etc.

Jeff Bezos, founder of Amazon says it aptly, "One of the only ways to get out of a tight box is to invent your way out." Our youth will steer the wheels of the future and walk the path on their own.

But it is our duty to ascertain that they are equipped and empowered with the requisite skills during the formative years. The collective vision should be to shape the future of India by nurturing entrepreneurial culture in our schools.

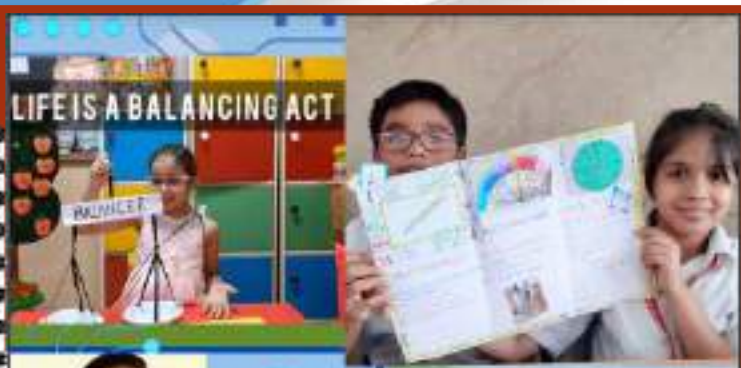


