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Dear Parents

The Scouting and Guiding mission is to contribute to the kids' education, through a value system that helps build a better world such that people are self-sustained as individuals and they play a key role in building a constructive society.

In an endeavor to ensure holistic development of our young learners, the school started a programme on Scouts and Guides in the last academic session, in collaboration with Hindustan Scouts and Guides Association. As the programme received an overwhelming response, we plan to continue the programme of Scouts and Guides for students of class IV.

Hindustan Scouts and Guides is an All-India Association recognized by Ministry of Sports and Youth Affairs, Govt. of India and the World Federation of Independent Scouts, Germany. It caters to an experimental method of exposing students to various aspects of physical training, community service, and nation building through recreation. Hindustan Scouts and Guides Association achieves its purpose of helping the students develop physically, intellectually, socially and spiritually. The programme aims at building confidence and self-esteem, learning important life skills and leadership skills, team building among the students. It is a blend of outdoor adventure, education and fun.

The details of the programme are as follows:

- Entire programme comprises of three courses-
 - 1. Praveshika (2 months)
 - 2. Rajat Jyoti (4 months)
 - 3. Swaran Jyoti (6 months)
- 2 classes for two hours each will be scheduled monthly for above mentioned courses. After completion of every course a test will be conducted to evaluate the students. The students will be eligible for Rajya Puraskar after completion of all the courses.
- ✤ 3 Camps will be organized in the school premises. Duration of the camp will be 3 days.
- 1 Camp will be organized outside the school for assessing the students.

The details of the Course fee are as follows:

The school will bear the registration fee for this prestigious programme, however students need to pay the following:

- Camp fee: Rs. 500/- Quarterly/Rs. 2,000/- Annually
- Cost of Dress: Rs. 750/- approximately

You are requested to pay the camp fee of Rs.2,000/- through a cheque drawn in favour of Bal Bharati Public School by 3 March 2023. School is only facilitating the camps and is not involved in commercials. No withdrawals shall be allowed after submission of the camp fee.
