ATTENDANCE

Every student must have a minimum of **75% attendance**, failing which he/she will not be allowed to sit in the final examination/will not be promoted to the next higher class, as per the CBSE guidelines.

Please discourage the student from missing an exam unless on grounds of extreme emergency like a contagious disease, fracture etc. for which a medical certificate from a certified government hospital practitioner and supporting medical reports must be submitted within one week of the absence.

SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT

The school will have 2 rounds of Unit Tests. The Unit Tests will be conducted for
25 Marks each.
(UT-1 will be conducted in the months of July- Aug 2023
UT-2 will be conducted in the months of Nov- Dec 2023)

Half Yearly and Annual exams will be conducted as per CBSE Assessment Scheme.
(Half Yearly Exams will be conducted in the month of Sept 2023
Annual Exams will be conducted in the months of Feb- March 2024)

☐ Theory Cumulative total will be computed as follows:

- 20% of UT
- 20% of HALF YEARLY
- 60% of ANNUAL EXAMINATION

☐ The numerical sum of the above weighted scores will be converted on a base of 80/70/30 as per the CBSE norms for that specific subject theory component, which is as follows:
