

Youth Entrepreneurship Bootcamp



Class V students interacted with students of partner school in November 2022 wherein they introduced themselves and shared information about languages spoken and popular cuisines of both countries through PPTs.



P2E: PASSPORT TO EARNING



School principal Geeta Gangwani shared a brief about initiatives and achievements of the institute for the period 2020-2022.


