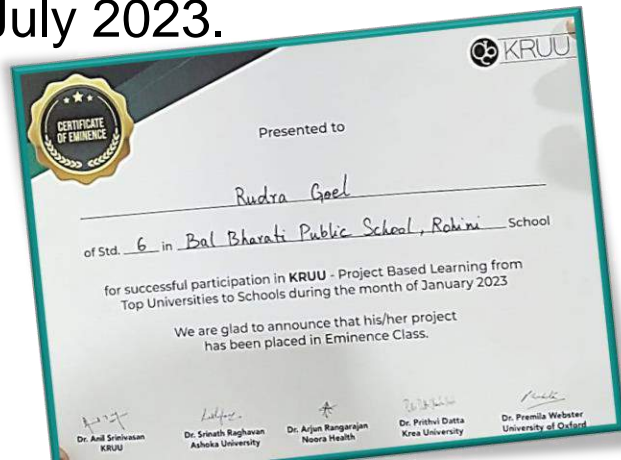

CREATIVE INTELLIGENCE BY KRUU

KRUU is a project based online learning platform that taps creative Intelligence of students. More than 300 schools from India under the guidance of research assistants for Oxford university and Krea university worked on projects 'The History of Geography' (classes VI-VIII) and '**Public Health Response**' (class IX) in January-February 2023. Projects of fifty-three students from BBPSRH were placed in the Eminence Class for being in top 5% amongst all participants. 442 students received certificates of Merit for being in top 25 %. Online Graduation and Award Ceremony in association with KRUU was held on 10 July 2023.
