

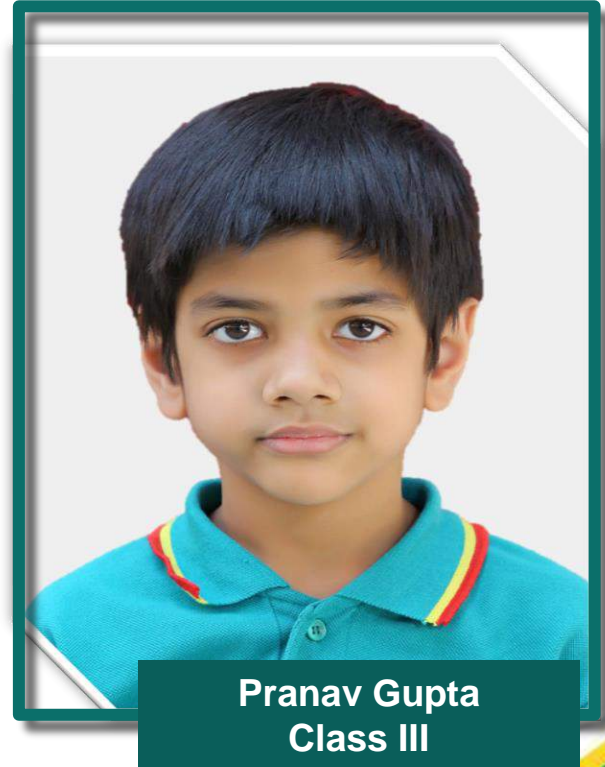

DISTRICT LEVEL CHILDREN SCIENCE CONGRESS 2023

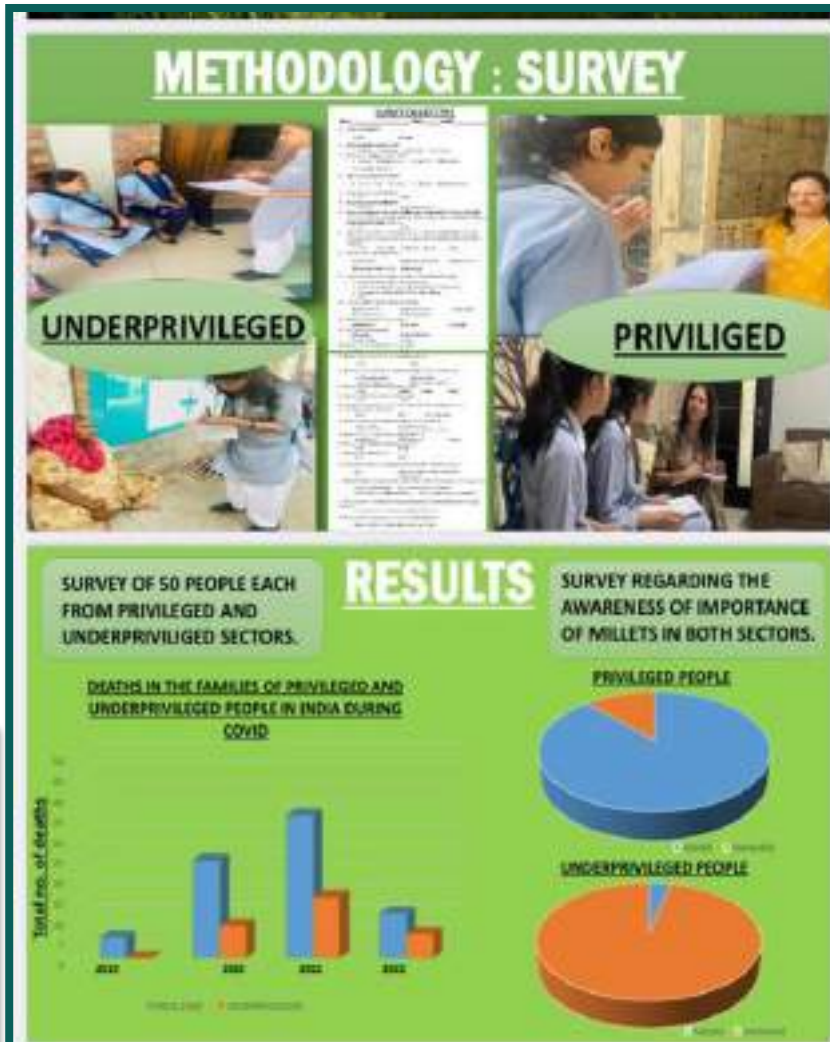

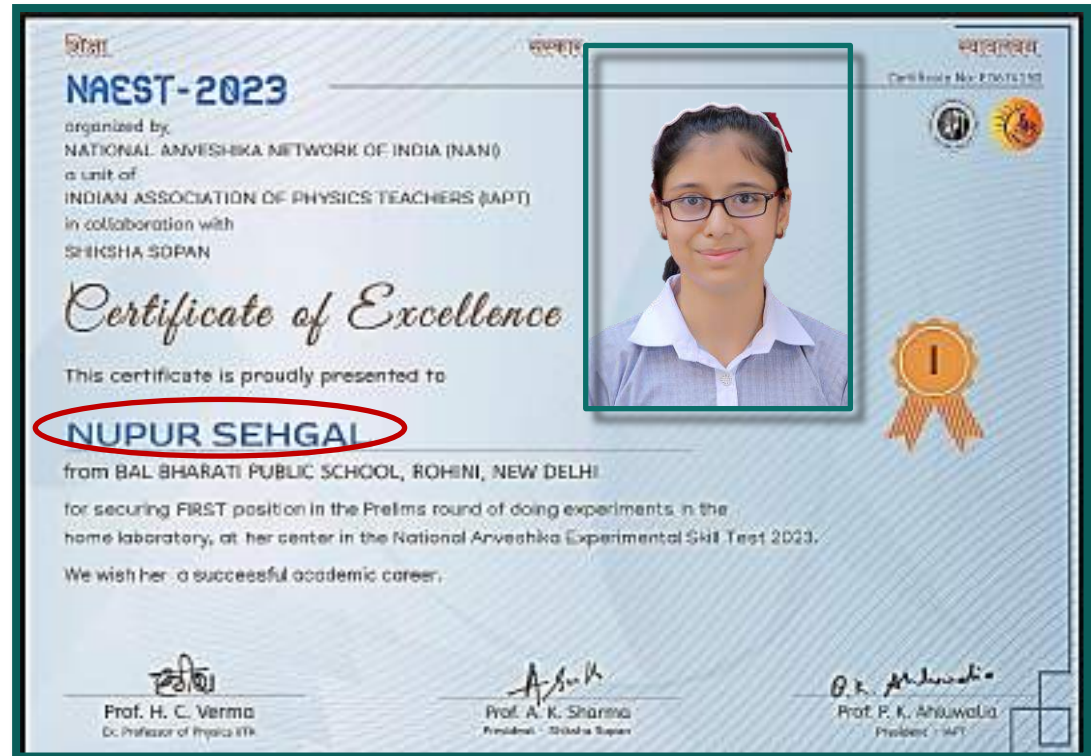

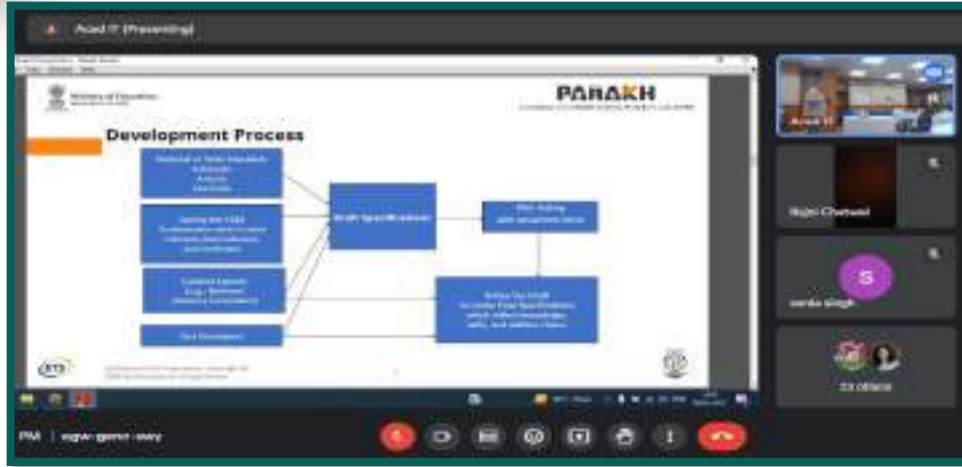
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FACULTY COMPETENCE

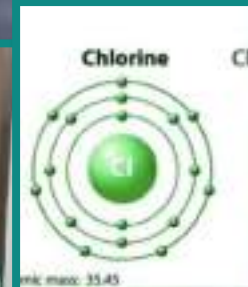


MOLE DAY 20 October 2023

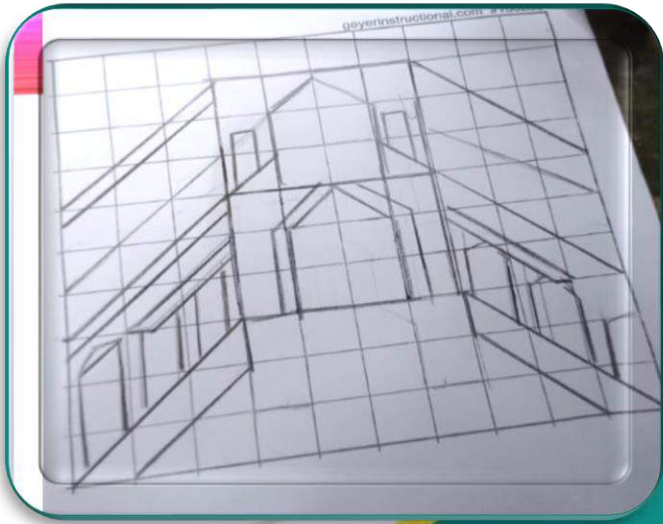
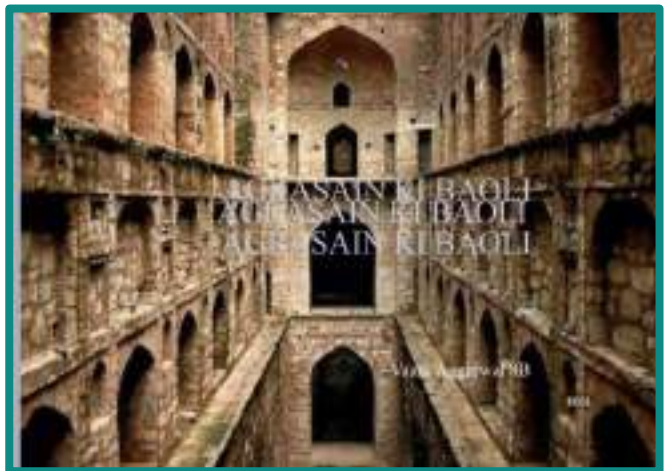


EDUCATION THROUGH MONUMENTS

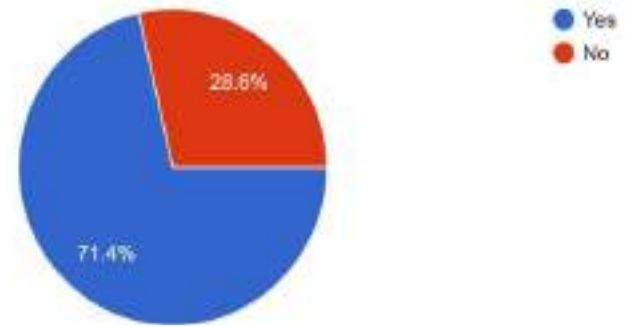

Half Yearly Exams were held for classes III-XII from 2 to 20 September 2023.

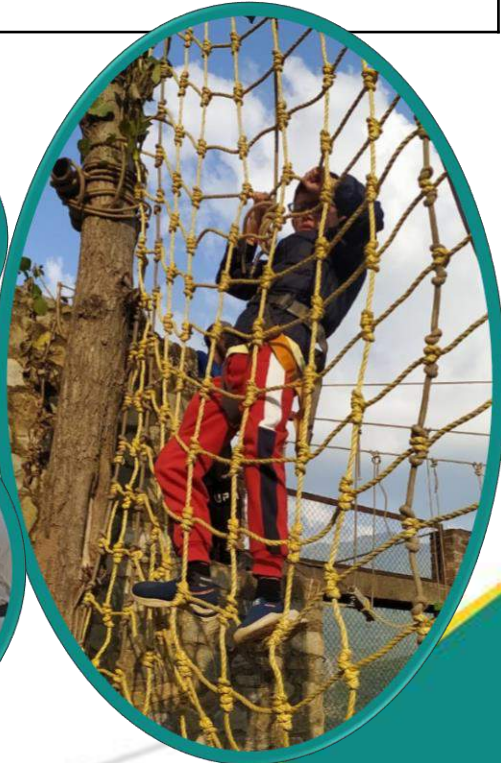
