








ASTRONOMY CLUB

COMPUTER CLUB HIGH-PERFORMANCE KIDS PROGRAMME

BBPSRH in collaboration with Primary Plus Research Academy is conducting the High-Performance Kids (HPK) Programme for Classes III & IV. The programme aims to train the students in key five computational concepts of coding through spatial and logical games and activities that teach computational speed , enhance the critical thinking ability in students and also develop in them understanding the importance of patterns that form the basis of Artificial Intelligence. The 40 hours programme started from October 2022 with emphasis on : Understanding 3D & Maze, Coding Basics, Directions. Coding through Kinesthetic Activities, through Vedic Maths, Patterns & Tasks, Flowcharts And Basics Of Coding through Board Games. 83 students have enrolled in HPK that eliminates exposure to computers, hence, no screen time is involved.


