# Grade IX Orientation: CBSE Guidelines for CWSN



The CBSE, being sensitive to children with special needs, is extending several exemptions/concessions to these students as defined in The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act - 2016



### REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY FOR PROVISIONS

Medical Report - can be issued by (for CBSE):

- Govt Hospital Central or State
- RCI licensed Clinical Psychologist with RCI No.
- NGO registered under RCI
- Please note: Medical reports are usually valid for 2 years from date of issue.
- Certificate that states diagnosis and provisions eligible for
- Annexure C mentions percentage of disability(40% and above). This is absolutely necessary for the CBSE.

All three must be signed and stamped

## GENERAL EXEMPTIONS / CONCESSIONS

- Facility of Scribe and Compensatory Time
- For Paper of 3 hours: 60 minutes
- For paper of 2.5 hours: 50 minutes
- For paper of 2 hours: 40 minutes
- For paper of 1.5 hours: 30 minutes
- The qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking examination.
- The arrangement of scribe is the responsibility of the parents and ID of the scribe along with application citing scribe details need to be submitted to the school before hand.
- Use of calculator is permitted only for children diagnosed with Specific Learning Disability(Dyscalculia). The term Dyscalculia must be mentioned in the report, certificate and annexure without fail for this to apply.

#### Flexibility in choosing subjects

- Subject Options available :
- **■** Fundamentals of Computer Applications(additional)
- Painting in lieu of Social Science/Science/Maths.
- **■** Exempted third language.
- Alternate Question/Separate Question for Social Science and Math: Visually Impaired (Please check which type of question are different via the latest CBSE sample papers for Grade X)
