






ENVIRONMENT CLUB




Collaboration with Taiwan School Disaster Management

Students actively exchanged ideas on effective disaster response plans and the drills practiced in their country. A quiz was conducted to assess their understanding of the disasters and its management at school level.


Students found it interesting that drills related to earthquakes were quite similar in both countries.
