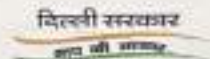

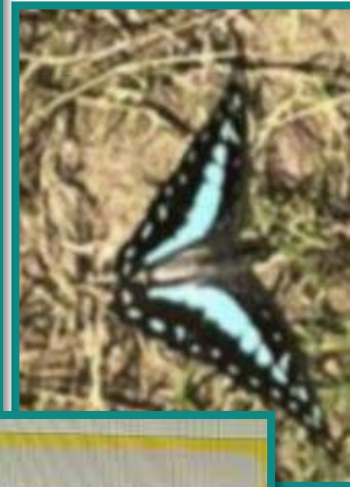

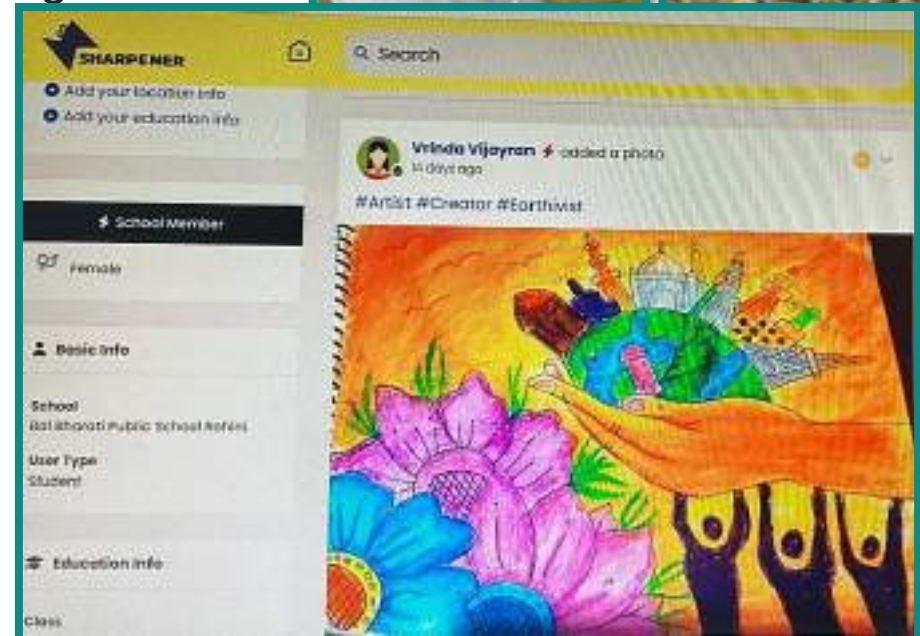


ENVIRONMENT CLUB

As per the recommendations of Bag Weight policy, weight of bags of students has been checked in every quarter. Necessary action has been taken.

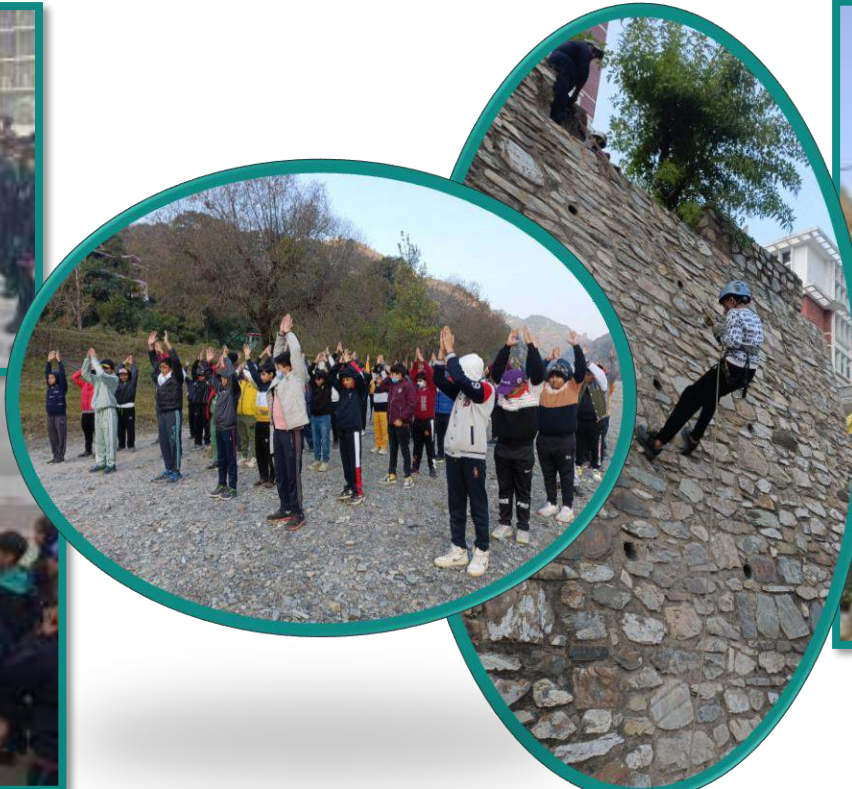
