## PASS CRITERIA FOR CLASS XI

In order to be declared as having passed the Class XI Examination, the student must have obtained:
A. A minimum of $33 \%$ marks in Theory Cumulative total and $33 \%$ in Practical INDIVIDUALLY for all the subjects
B. Minimum subject wise score of $33 \%$ in Annual Examination.

Both these criteria ( $A$ and $B$ ) must be fulfilled for a child to be declared passed andpromoted.

## ADDITIONAL SUBJECTS

It is mandatory for a student to pass in the additional subject in class XI as per passing criteria above.
For students who are unable to meet the passing criteria, a retest will bescheduled. Failure to fulfill the passing criteria after retest will lead to surrender of theadditional subject in Class XII.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR RETEST IN CLASS 11 / DETENTION:

A) A candidate obtaining less than $33 \%$ in one subject only will qualify for a retest inthe specific subject.
B) A candidate securing less than $33 \%$ in the retest shall be detained. In case of detention, no change of subject is permitted.
C) A candidate obtaining less than $33 \%$ in two or more subjects will be detained. Incase of detention, no change of subject is permitted.
