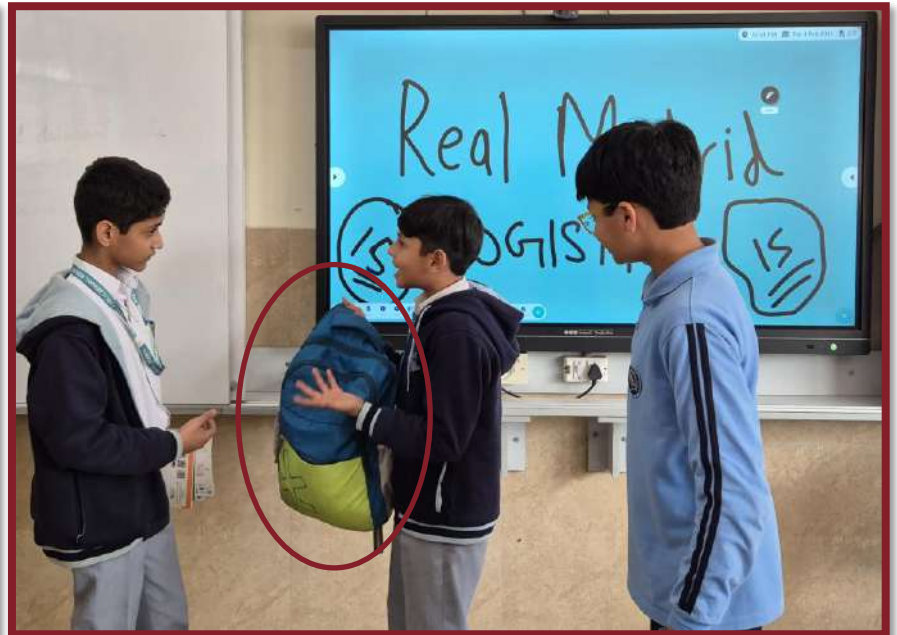
ATL CLUB

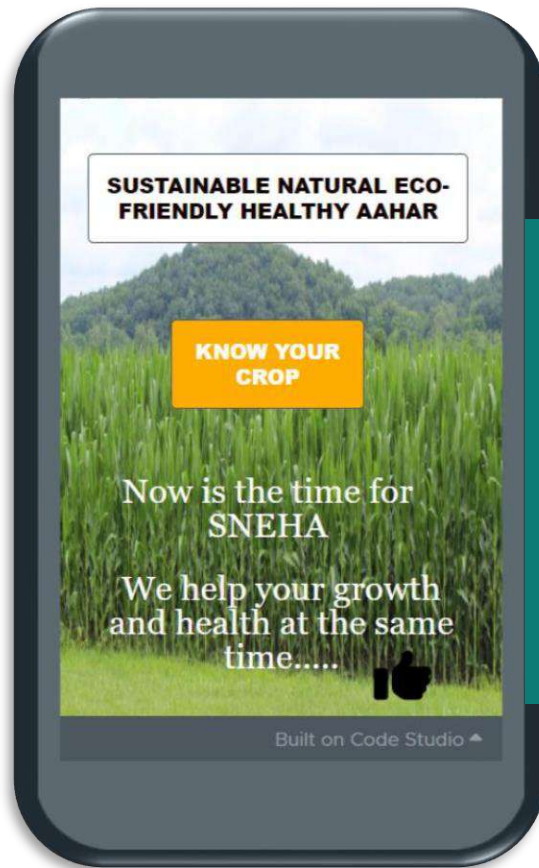

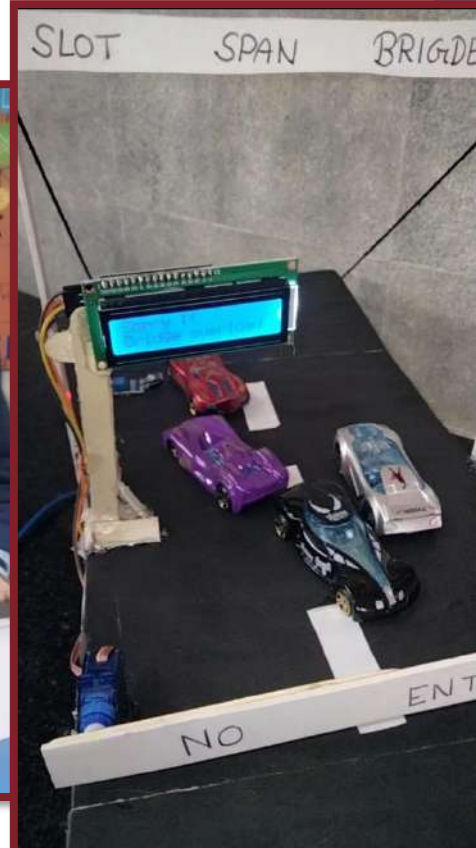

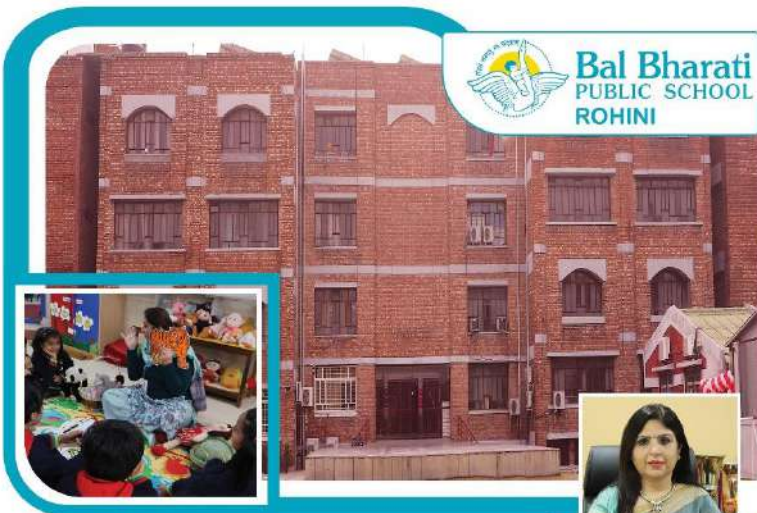
