#### CHAPTER : PLACE VALUE AND NUMBERS

We know that the largest 3-digit number is 999 ( Nine thousand, Nine hundred Ninety nine)

When we add 1 to 999 we get:

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{H T O} \\ 999 \\ + 1 \\ \hline \underline{1000} = \text{One Thousand} \end{array}$$

One Thousand is the smallest 4-digit number.
